Through the efforts of this foundation (with the help of people like you and I!) each family in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Albany Medical Center, St. Peter's Hospital, Stony Brook Hospital, Crouse Hospital (Syracuse), Golisano Children's Hospital, UHS Wilson Medical Center, Bellevue Women's Center, First Presbyterian Stanley Morgan Hospital, Women and Children's Hospital of Buffalo, Millard Fillmore Hospital as well as the Special Care Unit at Glens Falls Hospital receives, upon admission, a book to read to their baby.
